Let me introduce you to three interesting places for young people along Route 66 in Arizona.. They are the **Grand Canyon, the Meteorite Crater and Kitt Peak National Observatory**. These attractions are near Route 66 in Arizona. I believe young people enjoy these places.

First, is the Grand Canyon, created by the Colorado River cutting through a plateau in Arizona. There is the famous giant gorge. Its length is 447km, the width is 6~30km, and the depth is 1500m, the deepest of worlds gorges. In 1919 it was made a national park in America. In 1979 it was registered by UNESCO.

The second place I'll tell you about is the Meteorite Crater in the Arizona desert. The Meteorite Crater is a giant hole in the middle of the arid sandstone of the Arizona desert. The hole was formed 50,000 years ago, by the impact of a meteor. Looking the giant star trace, young people will be very surprised at that sight.

Next, I want you to know about Kitt Peak National Observatory. Kitt Peak National Observatory (KPNO) is a United States astronomical observatory. It is located on a 2,096 m peak of the Quinlan Mountains in the Arizona-Sonoran Desert. With 23 telescopes, it has the largest, most diverse collection of astronomical instruments in the world. It is wonderful!

I have introduced three places that young people (university age students) would enjoy in Arizona along Route 66. I recommend that you visit these three places. The Giant Grand Canyon and the Meteorite Crater will impress you. Kitt Peak National Observatory is a good place for university students to enjoy while learning. I wish you a good trip!
